AN ORDINANCE

Amending Article 507 (Traffic Control Maps) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Allentown:

The request is from the Administration. The Mayor is authorized to establish traffic regulations for a temporary period not to exceed 90 days. This legislation, in effect, would make the changes permanent. In terms of procedures, the temporary regulations are filed in the Clerk's Office until we collect a number of them, then we send them to Council for an Ordinance, usually at the direction of the Traffic Engineer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That pursuant to Section 507.02, Changes in Maps by Ordinance; Exception, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Allentown, authorizing amendments to the Traffic Control Maps of the City, the following traffic regulation is hereby made permanent.

STOP

Chester Street, at South 7th Street, making this a multi-way stop
South 9th Street at Tioga Street, a "T" intersection
North Graham Street at East Chew Street, a "T" intersection
Chester Street (westbound) at South Hall Street, a "T" intersection
East Clay Street at Wall Street, a "T" intersection
Delp Street at Adams Street
East Highland at Van Buren Street, a "T" intersection
30th Street S.W., at Diamond Avenue, a "T" intersection
30th Street S.W., at Moravian Avenue, a "T" intersection
Walnut Street at 14th Street, making this a 4-way stop

25 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Cumberland Street, from South 8th Street to South 10th Street
Whittier Drive, from Wyoming Street to Skyline Drive
East Lexington Street, from Albert Street to Gilmore Street
North New Street, from Washington to Sumner Avenue
Livingston Street, from 26th Street to Cedar Crest Boulevard
North 29th Street, from Tilghman Street to north of City line
Normandy Street, from South Law Street to South 4th Street

35 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Fish Hatchery Road, between Oxford Drive and Cedar Crest Blvd

CHANGE SPEED LIMIT

**Change from 30 MPH to 25 MPH, East Columbia Street,
from Sherman Street to Club Avenue**

NO PARKING

Ivy Street, from Catasauqua to Fern Streets

ONE WAY

Congress Street (eastbound), from 19th Street to 18th Street

SECTION TWO: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
