AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2010 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, DCED grant from State Representative Jennifer Mann to the Communications Bureau of the Police Department to provide for building security related equipment at the Communications Center.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2010 General Fund in the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, DCED grant to assist funding building security related equipment at the Communications Center.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Police Department, Technical Services program as follows:
