AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2010 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars from donations collected by Lincoln Elementary School Students and a One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollar donation from the Allentown Dog Training Club to the Police Department K-9 program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2010 General Fund in the amount of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from donations .

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Police Department, equipment account as follows:

Police Department – Police Operations:


